

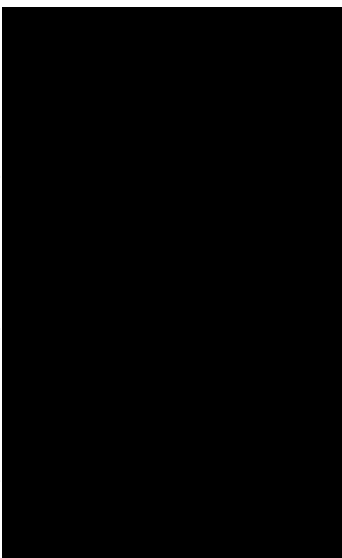

I wanted to bring to your attention some important information regarding the safety concerns related to cyclist safety and traffic flow at the Netball Courts. With the upcoming opening of your stand at the courts tomorrow, it is crucial to be aware of the following issues that have been raised by concerned individuals:

Cyclists merging onto the footpath or roadside on the netball side to cross the bridge: Due to the layout, cyclists are required to navigate past our entrance and exit ways. This poses a potential risk, especially considering the high volume of vehicles entering and exiting the carpark on Tuesdays, Friday nights (when there is no street lighting), and throughout the entire day on Saturdays.

Incorrectly positioned volunteer island causing traffic chaos: The current placement of the volunteer island outside our exit way is leading to significant confusion and chaos among vehicles exiting onto the main road. This has resulted in vehicles encroaching onto oncoming traffic heading towards the bridge, which raises concerns about the safety of cyclists who need to merge on that side.

Lack of turning point into the courts from the south causing traffic congestion: The absence of a turning point into the courts from the south has created substantial traffic jams, particularly exacerbated by the Pioneer exit and entrance point in close proximity. Under the pressure to alleviate congestion, drivers are resorting to dangerous turns, posing a risk of serious incidents in the near future. The presence of cyclists further adds to the potential dangers.

I strongly encourage you to consider these issues and the impact they may have on the safety of all participants and visitors at the Netball Courts. While this message serves to raise awareness, I also invite you to witness these concerns firsthand tomorrow. If you are available, I would be happy to accompany you and provide a detailed overview of the specific danger points.

Thank you for your attention to this matter. By being aware of these potential risks, we can work together to ensure the safety and well-being of everyone involved.

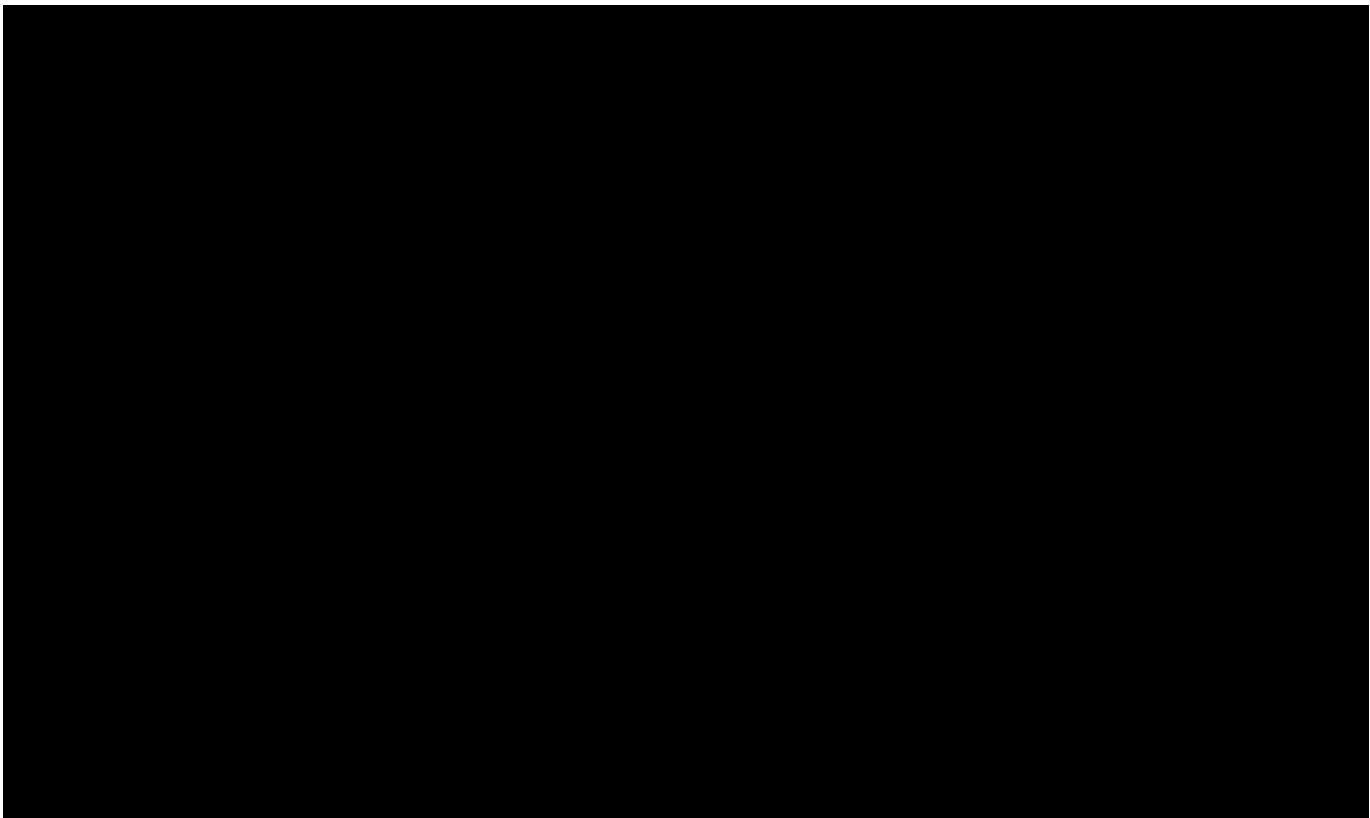

Is there a need for a cycleway? How many of our community ride cycles in Masterton? The Red Star Sports Association is made up of members fro Rugby, Cricket, Squash and Table Tennis Clubs and our complex is used most days by our members. Our main hall is used by Community groups when our members do not use the main hall. Therefore if the proposal goes through then it would be an inconveniece to lose the on road parking. Yes we have a small car park but at times it is more convenient to park on the roadside if we are delivering goods or food to the complex in major events. Car park would be full on big event days. Herbert Street is not a quiet urban street. There is a Sports Complex, A Motel and a School on it and then we have all the residents in the area known as the "Bird Sanctuary" whose only access is from Herbert street. Also you have Memorial Park in Dixon Street around the corner and on larger game days cars are parked and travel down Herbert Street. Parking for Chanel Court Motel has been an issue for Red STar members with the trucks blocking the view down Herbert Street. This has been resolved but if the motel lost the street parking on the Southern side of Herbert street there is not enough roomon the northern side between driveways for the large vehicles to park which could affect the motels business.

If the proposal to take the route up Herbert Street then the grass berm needs to be taken away and that becomes the cycleway then there would be no change to any parking in Herbert Street. All the power poles are on the Northen side of Herbert Street and there would be the loss of four small bushes outside the college. By using the grass berm you could still have a footpath and dual cycle path.

This would be safer than coming out of Herbert Street and using the footpath in Dixon Street to get to Crayne Street. This alternative route could link up to a cycleway on the West side of Masterton linking the schools Wairarapa College, Douglas Park and St Matthews College

What do you think about the proposed cycleway and route?

I like that the council is finding new ways to promote alternatives to personal vehicles & cycle tracks in the town are quite limited / unsafe currently.

The only concerns I have about the proposed route is the effect it will have on parking for some of the businesses on Colombo Rd. As a customer, I rely on parking being available to adequately serve those businesses. I appreciate the street side parking is still made available but this will still make finding a park nearby, relatively difficult.

Are there improvements you think could be made to the design of the proposed route?

Would it be possible to have the cycleway share the footpath for the stretches of parking outside the shops? This would ensure enough parking is available & would only affect the cycleway for a few dozen metres.

Submission to Masterton District Council

June 2023

We support improved low-carbon travel choices as climate change makes action urgent. We especially support active transport where possible, with its benefits for mental and physical health and general low impact on the environment.

Masterton is potentially ideal for all ages cycling for many travel journeys, being mostly flat and with reasonable weather, although e-bikes and good clothing can overcome hills, winds and rain more easily. Cycling is a cheap way to get around. It's much more affordable than having a second car for many families, and provides independence for those who do not have access to a car. We note that the 200 bus and the Wairarapa trains have some bicycle carriage provisions so a connection to Solway, Renall and Masterton stations will be important.

We'd like to see stronger statements in the "why" part, possibly "To meet our climate, safety, equity and liveability goals, we need to increase cycling as a proportion of travel journeys. With most urban journeys less than 5km, this is achievable in Masterton."

We generally support Masterton District Council's proposal for a cycle route from the netball courts to Kuripuni. [Lansdowne to Kuripuni Cycleway - Masterton District Council \(mstn.govt.nz\)](#)

In the 2017 Masterton Cycling Strategy, Rautaki Paihikara o Whakaoriori¹, urban cycling includes the route in Map 1. No protected cycle routes exist in Masterton yet, so this needs to be well done and prove itself by connecting enough destinations and origins of travel. We are pleased that Waka Kotahi funding will enable this proposal to go ahead but saddened that since the 2017 strategy was agreed so little has been physically achieved.

Lakeview School, Chanel College, Makoura College, the teen parent unit at Makoura, Te Kura Kaupapa Māori o Wairarapa, and several nearby Early Childhood Centres, will all benefit from this proposal. So will the Kuripuni Shopping Village.

Sportspeople at Masterton Rugby Club and Masterton Netball Courts may be able to warm up on their journey and there's good access to the Masterton Trails along Te Awa Waipoua for recreational riding. Geraldine Inder Dance Studio is another organisation that could benefit from young people being more independent. The wider Wairarapa is potentially excellent for cycling and there is already considerable road-riding, mountain-biking and long-distance bike-packing e.g. Tour Aotearoa route. Colombo and Kuripuni provide access to many of the potential cycling routes, including Wairarapa Valley Cycleway, the Tararua Traverse and Route 52, as listed on Ngā Haerenga website.

To address climate change and the emissions from vehicles, it's the journeys of 5km and less we need to collectively address. The proposed cycleway will be safe enough for students, and those new to cycling. Older people might need an e-bike or tricycle, and families may use cargo-bikes so don't skimp on the width. It must not reduce the safety and pleasure of people on foot. Any cycling use of footpaths should be minimal, slow and separate.

Masterton has a high number of car parks (on domestic properties, other roads and in business car parking) for residents, visitors and shoppers per capita so we don't believe reduction in parking for private property should get in the way of a good cycleway project. We recognise that due to the surrounding rural areas, many people will continue to rely on private vehicle access to Masterton, but Colombo Street can provide some space for cycling.

Moving to the detail, there are few on-road bi-directional cycleways in the Wellington region. A preferred option would be one-way lanes on both sides if possible. It's more intuitive for people on bikes, people on footpaths, and people driving in and out of driveways. If MDC does proceed with the bi-directional option, education for cyclists and other road-users is critical.

Separation from moving motor vehicles is good, especially for younger and less confident cyclists so we support the concrete separating kerbs shown in the cross-section diagram to discourage encroachment by other vehicles.

It is not clear how much of the footpath will remain on the shared section and how it will be delineated. We would prefer the bi-directional path to continue all the way on the carriageway. If this is not possible, we suggest a change in level or something so that people using wheelchairs, pushchairs, frail people and people with low-vision are not unnerved by fast cyclists.

We understand that students travelling from the Cameron Block to Lakeview may use the footpath but we would like the assurance that its width meets appropriate guidelines².

Will the crossing from one side to the other be light-controlled or a proper cycle and pedestrian (with separated areas) crossing that other vehicles must stop at? A courtesy crossing is not sufficient.

People on bikes need to access destinations such as the stores, church, dance school etc. It makes more sense to connect with these destinations than avoid them.

We don't think the two alternative routes suggested are an improvement.

Much more needs to be done, particularly to the west of SH2, connecting to the Five Towns Trail, railway stations and other schools, potentially Pownall Street, but this is a commendable start.

We would like to speak in support of this submission.
